

Radiator Guard Installation Instructions

Model : Suzuki RMZ 450
Year : 2018-
Part No: FA-001-SZ-10

Tools required:
10 mm T-bar, 8mm T-bar and 8mm spanner

1. Remove the seat and radiator shrouds. The bolts highlighted in figure 1 are required to be removed to do this. Note two of the shroud bolts are covered by the seat.

2. Remove the plastic radiator guard and undo the bolt attaching the radiator to the chassis.

3. Fasten Radiator guards using 8mm T-bar to chassis with both sides fitted loosely. Tighten the top radiator brace bolt shown in figure 2 and 3, holding the brace in the position displayed in figure 3, with the rear hole aligned with the mounting point on the bike. For the left hand side ensure the spacer is placed between the brace and the radiator guard for the lower bolt and tightened.

4. Fit the shrouds on both sides, tighten the top bolts displayed in figure 4 first then tighten the lower bolt of the guard and brace for the right hand side and the middle bolt for the left hand side. Lastly tighten the rear brace bolt and use the 8mm spanner to tighten the front radiator mounting bolts that should have remained loose until now.

5. Refit the seat and you are now ready to ride.
